

Directive Paragraph

When cleaning dental instruments, there are a few steps when followed correctly will result in properly sterilized equipment. First, take the dirty instruments and put them into a ultrasonic sterilizer filled with cleaner solution. By putting the tools into the sterilizer, it vibrates to clean the blood and debris off of the sharp tips. After they stay in there for ten minutes, take them out and rinse them off with warm water. Once they are rinsed, they are placed into steam sterilization pouches. Next, put them into a machine called the Autoclave, which sterilizes the instruments fully with an abundance of steam and they are left in there for thirty to forty-five minutes. When the time is up, the tools are fully sterilized for next use.

There are specific steps that must be followed before giving a patient an intramuscular vaccine. It is imperative that the steps be done correctly for the vaccine to work. First use two identifiers each time a patient is given a vaccine. Ask the patient to verbally state their name and date of birth. Then gather all equipment necessary such as an alcohol wipe, one sterile 2 x 2 gauze pad, a new needle typically a 1 to 1 ½ in., syringe and disposable gloves. Wipe the area on the injection site then prepare the needle. The syringe should be held with the dominant hand and the other hand should be used to pull the cover off. The syringe needs to be placed between the thumb and first finger. Hold the skin around the injection site with one hand. While using the free hand to gently press on and pull the skin so that it is slightly tight. Next use the wrist to inject the needle through the skin and into the muscle at a 90-degree angle and insert the needle. Push down on the plunger to inject the medicine. After the medicine is injected remove the needle at the same angle it went in. Lastly, place a gauze over the injection site and cover with a piece of tape. Following these steps will increase the chances of the vaccine working on the patient.

When creating a still life drawing, there are several steps that must be taken in order to attain a realistic looking still life. A strong realistic still life begins with a perfectly scaled line drawing of the subject. Without a scaled line drawing, there is no strong foundation for the artist to add any value or details. After accurately scaling the subject the artist is ready for the next step of adding value. Adding value simply means to shade your subject, shading can be done from dark to light. Typically, wherever the lighting hits your subject is where the lightest of values should be applied and wherever there's the least lighting the darkest of values should be applied. Once the artist has applied their value, the value must be blended to achieve a softness in their subject, however this step is optional – it is up to the artist to determine what style they'd like to incorporate in their still life drawing. Lastly, the artist must clean up any leftover residue from their pencil in order to prevent smudging or ruining their still life entirely. After all these steps are completed, the artist should have achieved a realistic looking still life drawing!
